Snowshoeing in Parc National des Monts-Valin



SNOWSHOE AMONG THE **GHOSTS AND MUMMIES.** 

With a fresh blanket of snow, the dwarf trees of Parc National des Monts-Valin (Saguenay-Lac-Saint-Jean) take on mysterious shapes, making them look like "ghosts" and "mummies". Snowshoeing is the best way to discover the mindblowing Vallée des Fantômes that peaks at 984 metres. Cross-country and downhill skiing also provide unique vantage points of the forest.

"FLY" BY BIKE THROUGH THE TREES. Suspended from a one-kilometre network of cables, VéloVolant riders pedal through the treetops, soaring over ravines and cliffs and criss-crossing the heights of Au Diable Vert, the breathtaking ski hills of Glen Sutton (Eastern Townships). These one-ofa-kind bicycles operate until late November or longer, weather permitting. You can also spend the night in a "treegloo", an elevated artificial igloo, or a tree-house.

北京 RIDE AND DINE. Since last year, the Train of Le Massif de Charlevoix has offered passengers an extraordinary culinary and sightseeing experience. Admire the majestic St. Lawrence River between Québec City and La Malbaie (Charlevoix) and stop at Le Massif, one of North America's most stunning ski resorts. Spend the night at La Ferme, a magnificent hotel featuring highly acclaimed design elements and architecture.
